Must be "either individually registered in the AKC "Stud Book" or is part of an AKC-registered litter, or otherwise if whelped outside the United State of America and owned by a resident of the USA, Canada, Mexico or Bermuda must have been registered in its country of birth with a foreign registry organization whose pedigree is acceptable for American Kennel Club registration.

A dog with an AKC Limited Registration is eligible for entry in licensed or Member Club Field Trials."

Important Information

Directions: To the Fairgrounds from I-5 take exit 49. Turn left and follow road into Castle Rock. At second stop turn right. Go over river and turn left at first road to your left. Follow until road T's at river, turn right into the fairgrounds.

To the running grounds: Follow directions above except do not turn past the river, continue to stop. A Texaco is at this intersection. Turn left. The turn for the running grounds is on your left where the first road on your right intersects.

Motel: Timberland Inn - phone 360-274-6002.

FOOD: Breakfast and Lunch will be served. Cost will be posted.

Camping: \$10.00 per sleeping vehicle per night at the fairgrounds. Electric hookup on first come basis. Park only on gravel areas.

Do not drive or park on grass.

Kennels: First come first served.
Users are required to clean kennels after use.

Fairground Rules: KEEP IT CLEAN.

Put trash in garbage cans in and just outside big red barn.

Clean up all dog waste and put in garbage.

DO NOT put anything except paper towels in cans in restrooms.
