**THE CLUB RESERVES** the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

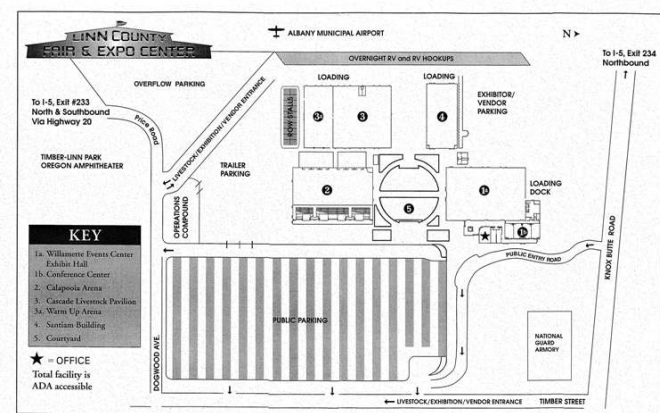

## GENERAL INFORMATION AND SHOW RULES

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:** A \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee and \$.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). If the Same Dog is entered in more than one class, the highest priced class shall be considered the first entry.

**CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES** is WEDNESDAY, 5 PM, MARCH 17, 2010 , after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or changed except as provided for in Ch. 11, Sec. 6, AKC Rules.
